## **Nottinghamshire Juniors win national night event**

At the 'Peter Palmer' Relay Event held at Beverley, Yorkshire, the Nottinghamshire Orienteering Junior Squad were in dominant form, with their two teams finishing first and fourth. The relay is for eight runners, at least two of whom should be of a different sex, and starts in the middle of the night. 34 teams from all over the UK competed.

This win retained the Peter Palmer trophy for NOC, and with a second (much younger) team already able to finish fourth, the club looks likely to dominate the two annual night/day relay events for some years to come.
