## PETER PALMER RELAYS 10/11 SEPT 2011

BAOC will again be hosting the PP Relays, this time at Beacon Barracks, MOD Stafford The area is a mix of urban, open parkland and woodland, all within the fenced area for added safety. However, we have been offered excellent support by the barrack authorities which will give us a gym hall to run the event from, as well as an accommodation block nearby.

**Event:** The intention is to give juniors the opportunity to experience

the excitement of a competition environment, similar to some

of the larger national and international events.

Registration: Beacon Barracks, Just off June 14 of the M6. Follow signs to

MOD Stafford Main gate at Grid SJ930250. Postcode ST16 3PS. Teams need to bring sleeping bags and roll mats, accommodation is in an accm block near the Gym, with some camp beds available in each room, but not enough for every member of the team. Teams will be allocated a specific room and expected to stay

in that room. Officials and helpers are in the same block.

Timings: Camp open from 1500hrs. All adults will need some form of photo ID to gain

access to the camp. Registration from 1600hrs Sat 10 Sep. Evening meal available from 1700-1800hrs on a pay yourself basis. Race starts 0430hrs. Breakfast is from 0800-0900hrs and is included in the entry fee. Prize giving

approximately 0915hrs.

Competition: The race is over 6 laps, at least 2 laps must be run by girls and at least 2 laps by

boys. Courses standards range from Yellow to Green. For full details see BOF

Competition Rule M. Teams of 6 can enter these classes if eligible:

Peter Palmer Trophy: All of team must be from same club.

Joan George Trophy: All of team from same club, combined age <91.

Nor OC Anniversary Trophy: Small club/s competition.

Entries: Method of entry is by post using the entry form overleaf, which is also available

from the BAOC website at www.baoc.org.uk. Please send form with chqs to Allan Farrington, PPR 2011, Kitchener House, Longmoor Camp, GU33 6DS. Cost is £10 per person, which includes hire of an emit card, and breakfast.

Cost for non-competitors is £7.

Eligibility: All competitors must be in the age range M/W12 to M/W18. Any BOF

registered club may enter teams. For details on small clubs combining to form

teams please see BOF Competition Rule M. Standard EMIT controls will be used.

Activities: After the evening meal there will be some form of activity, details to follow.
