Report on East Midlands Meeting – 28th January 2013

Treasurer's Report - The treasurer presented the budget monitoring report for July 2012 to Jan 2013, together with details of event income and numbers. Expenditure on trophies and awards for the EM champs and league had exceeded budget but this could be met from the bank balance and the expenditure was necessary.

A person was needed to co-ordinate the EM Champs trophies.

Grant Applications - Two grant applications were received and approved for members to attend courses and also attend foreign competitions.

EM League Events - The EM League for 2012 was successfully concluded (see results elsewhere in EMEWS) and a full programme of events is scheduled for 2013.

NOC were concerned that Byron's Walk had been excluded from the EM League just because it did not have a Short Green course. The committee confirmed that all courses need to be included for an event to be part of the EM League. All controllers need to ensure that if they are controlling an EM League event that all of the courses are available.

Handicapping in the EM League - A number of queries were raised about the handicapping of juniors and some older competitors in the EM League. However, there were no details so the clubs were asked to provide more evidence so an appraisal could be done to see if there were changes needed to the rules. Once the evidence was available an appraisal would take place and, if necessary, changes would be recommended.

Shadowing of Juniors - The national rules on shadowing juniors have changed and our rules are different. We need to review the changes and ensure that any clarification, if needed, is made to our rules for the EM League events.

Future Events:

- (i) Midland Championships 2013 - NOC - February 3rd at Sherwood Forest.
- (ii) CompassSport Cup and Trophy 1st Round on 17th February 2013 - LEI to host the Level B Event - Fineshade Woods.
- (iii) British Sprint Championships 2013 - LEI - April 20th at Loughborough University.
- (iv) British Middle Championships 2013 - DVO - April 21st at Stanton Moor. Site visit has taken place.
- (v) Yvette Baker Trophy Final 2013 - LOG - July 7th - Belton Park - site visit taken place.
- (vi) British Schools Champs 2013 - DVO - November 17th at Shipley Park

Development - Ranald explained that there had been some confusion over the proposed development days but the final arrangements are:

- 27 April - officials conference at Rushcliffe - Hilary Palmer and John Duckworth have confirmed they will run sessions; waiting to hear from Barry Elkington - club reps to encourage people to attend
- Mappers course (two days) needed in May or soon after - David to take action on this with Roger Edwards and to discuss with Mike Godfree for DVO

- Planners course - Ranald to speak to Mike Gardner and Peter Hubberstey with a view to a course being run in September

EM Committee - All of the current EM Officials in the 4 key roles will be standing down at the AGM. Since the last meeting, approaches had been made to various people but, so far, without success. The meeting discussed other models for operating at a regional level if officials could not be found - for example, the Club representatives could meet say four times a year, rotating the chairmanship, to co-ordinate actions set out in the Development Plan. There would be a need to someone to take notes and for the financial issues to be dealt with.

Coaching Report (Hilary Palmer)

- I have arranged an EMOA Coaches update workshop for the afternoon of Sat April 6th at Rushcliffe Country Park (room booked) and all coaches have been notified and will be again in 1 months time. I do hope that clubs will encourage their coaches to attend as this offers a local opportunity to gain further information and personal development and it is free.
- All coaches have also been asked to send me their coaching logs in the next 2 months. This is so that we (regional coaching coordinators) can see who is active and what sort of personal development that have been able to source for themselves and what I can try to provide locally.
- I attended the BOF Coaching Conference last weekend and there was a very interesting mix of sessions. Notably, Paul Murgatroyd gave a very good session on fun warm-ups and cool-downs and Jackie Newton (BOF Talent Squad coach) gave good sessions on the work of the BOF Talent Squad and also on annual and weekly training programme planning and in groups we tried some of that planning with someone who acted as an example athlete. Richard Lecky-Thompson led an interesting strength and conditioning practical workshop. there were 2 coaches from LEI there - good to see that they made it through the snow!
- John Palmer and I also attended the Internal Verifier and coach education sessions (Judith Holt was also at the latter) and there were useful discussions at both sessions. Of interest to local clubs, perhaps, was agreement to reduce the training days for the UKCCL1 from 3 to 2 and I will be taking this forward over the next month. At the last Coaching Committee meeting it was agreed that the coaching awards need to be more tailored to meet the needs of coaches in clubs and especially in community clubs. Reducing the time (and cost) commitment for L1 is part of this work. We hope to look at the L2 tasks as part of this initiative too.

- A Coaching Needs Group is currently discussing the needs of coaches and clubs/regions for coaches and we will be reporting to the Board in the next month. This is part of the work by the Board to try to align the governance better to what is needed in the sport. Coaching Committee as we know it will disappear but there may be some other form of

volunteer workforce group(s) to take this forward. I am on the Coaching Needs Group and if anyone has any observations about this please let me have them as soon as possible.

EMOA Mapping Report (David Olivant)

- **EMOA Development - Experienced Mappers Workshop** - The Experienced Mappers Workshop was held on 8 December at Groby with 15 attendees including Mick Lucking and myself.
- **EMOA Development - Novice Mapper Training** - I have had discussions earlier this month with Ranald, Paul Murgatroyd and Roger Edwards about the mapper training elements of the EMOA Development day. The priority is to provide mapper training for new mappers to support updates to event maps. This is a UK wide issue and, as Map Advisory Group chair, I propose that the training we deliver for EMOA will serve as a pilot for standardised novice mapper courses. The current position is:
 - From previous experience we know that two days are required to deliver an effective course.
 - The course will include the Mapper Safety module required by British Orienteering.
 - Training material from previous mapper courses is available but this should be developed further to meet the needs of novice mappers.
 - I hope that the location and date of one of the two days can be tied in with Ranald's proposals (for example 27 April), the other will need to be held within a week or two of this date but could be at a separate location. Groby and Riseholme have been discussed/offered as possible locations.
 - My original concern about trainee numbers, (too many) can be resolved by improved delivery. Current interest is LEI 5-6, LOG 2, NOC 1, this is manageable.
 - The courses need to be held by mid-May at the latest, earlier if possible.

National Forest - LEI may be involved in the opening of a long distance footpath. LEI/DVO webmasters to liaise about the events held by DVO in the National Forest.

Future Meetings - All meetings to be held at the Pace Room, St Mary's Church, Clifton Village, Nottinghamshire at 7.30 p.m. The dates are 15th April 2013 and then 15th July 2013. All members are able to attend the meetings.

Lagganlia 2012



This summer I was selected to go to the Lagganlia week long training camp in Scotland. I travelled by train from the Welsh 6 Days on the Saturday with some of the other athletes who also came from the Welsh 6 Days.

First thing on Sunday morning we spent a little time learning the other athletes names using Brian, Brenda and Backwards, three teddy bears.

We then started training, on Moor of Alvie in the morning and Uath Lochan in the afternoon. We practiced visualisation and contours on Moor of Alvie, a forested, undulating area, as well as recording our personal one kilometre times through terrain and along paths, it made me realise how much slower I am on terrain than on paths. Uath Lochan is another wooded area, slightly steeper than Moor of Alvie and with a few more paths. Here we practiced bearings and pacing. At the end of the day, we did a star relay with Brian, Brenda and some other teddy bears.

On the Monday we had a very short walk to the area, the Lagganlia chequerboard, rightly named as for some reason there is a chequerboard of rides with the greenness of the forest in each square different from those around it. The focus was on simplification, so we started with a blank piece of paper and a master map and we had to draw a simplified map of the area with the course on and then go and run the course just using our simplified map. I did really well at this and learnt that I actually don't need to use anywhere near as much detail as is on a standard orienteering map.

Tuesday's training was on Roseisle, an area of sand dunes, which will be used for the Scottish Six Days next year. The training was, unsurprisingly, about contours and contour simplification. At the end we had a "green" run, not describing the difficulty but the colour of the forest we had to run through! We also had an odds and evens relay. This was my favourite area of the week. We then stopped off at Aviemore to buy some sweets.

On Wednesday we had a sprint competition with an A and B final and a qualifier. The qualifier was in Lagganlia and the surrounding woodland. The final was at another outdoor centre nearby. Afterwards we went for a swim in Loch Morlich.

Thursday's training was on Battan where the focus was on map memory. I did quite well at that. At the end we had a peg relay. The start was interesting, the coaches threw all the maps in the air and then everyone started running in completely the wrong direction down the path. There was a large crush at the first control and then someone started running off with the SI box and dropped it down a hole! In the evening, we had a Barbeque and we did some Trail O around the woods next to Lagganlia, organized by the cooks.

On the last day, we had a classic race on Loch Vaa, a moorland sort of area with blocks of woodland with indistinct veg boundaries. It was hard work and very hot. Finally, we had a relay at Avie Lochan, which is undulating runnable terrain with vague patches of woodland.

The Lagganlia training camp is organized by the Junior Regional Orienteering Squads for top year M/W14s. To go you have to be nominated by your region and have achieved a Championship standard at M/W14. A maximum of 24 athletes from the UK are invited each year.

I really enjoyed my week and learnt a lot. I would like to thank LEI and EMOA for their generous grants towards my participation.
