Beginners are welcome!

- Travel** The event takes place at Walesby Scout Camp, Brake Road, Walesby, Newark, Notts NG22 9NG. It is accessed from the A614 Blyth Road between Ollerton and Clumber Park.
- Parking** Parking will be on Hall Field. Marshals will be available to direct you. There will be a £2 per car parking charge.
- Facilities** Enquiries, Registration, Download and Results will be situated in Marquee 2 in the Scout Complex.
Toilets and changing facilities are available near to the Marquee.
- Entry** No pre-entry. Enter on the day.

- If you are not a member of NOC or LOG you can either run in an open chase race where your start time will be between 10.50am and 10.59am, depending on your age class, or you can run any of the courses with a start time of your choice between 10.30 and 12.30 when the chase races are not starting.
- Newcomers are welcome but please seek advice from the volunteers at assembly. A sample orienteering map will be available.
- Note that the SI electronic timing boxes will not operate in contactless mode and must be punched by all competitors.
- Registration** Registration will be open from 10:00 and will close at 12:00.
Fees: Seniors £4, Juniors/Students £2.
SI hire: £1. Extra maps: 50p.
- Start Times** 10:30 -12:30 but few minute interval starts will be available on chase courses between 10.50 and 11.30.
The start is close to registration and there is a warm up area between the Marquee and the start.

Control Descriptions

Loose control descriptions will be available in the start lanes. Control descriptions will also be printed on the map.

Terrain

Parkland, with some forest areas.

Maps

A4 for all courses. Scale 1:10 000. Contours 5m intervals. The maps will be printed on waterproof paper.

Finish

First Aid will be available at assembly which is adjacent to the finish.

Safety

Competitors take part at their own risk. Full leg cover must be worn.

Longer courses pass near to a small river. Take particular care in these locations.

These are public areas. Please be courteous to members of the public including cyclists, children playing, etc.

Courses will close at 13:30 after which controls will be collected. You must report to download even if you miss the cut-off time as this will avoid a search being instigated.
