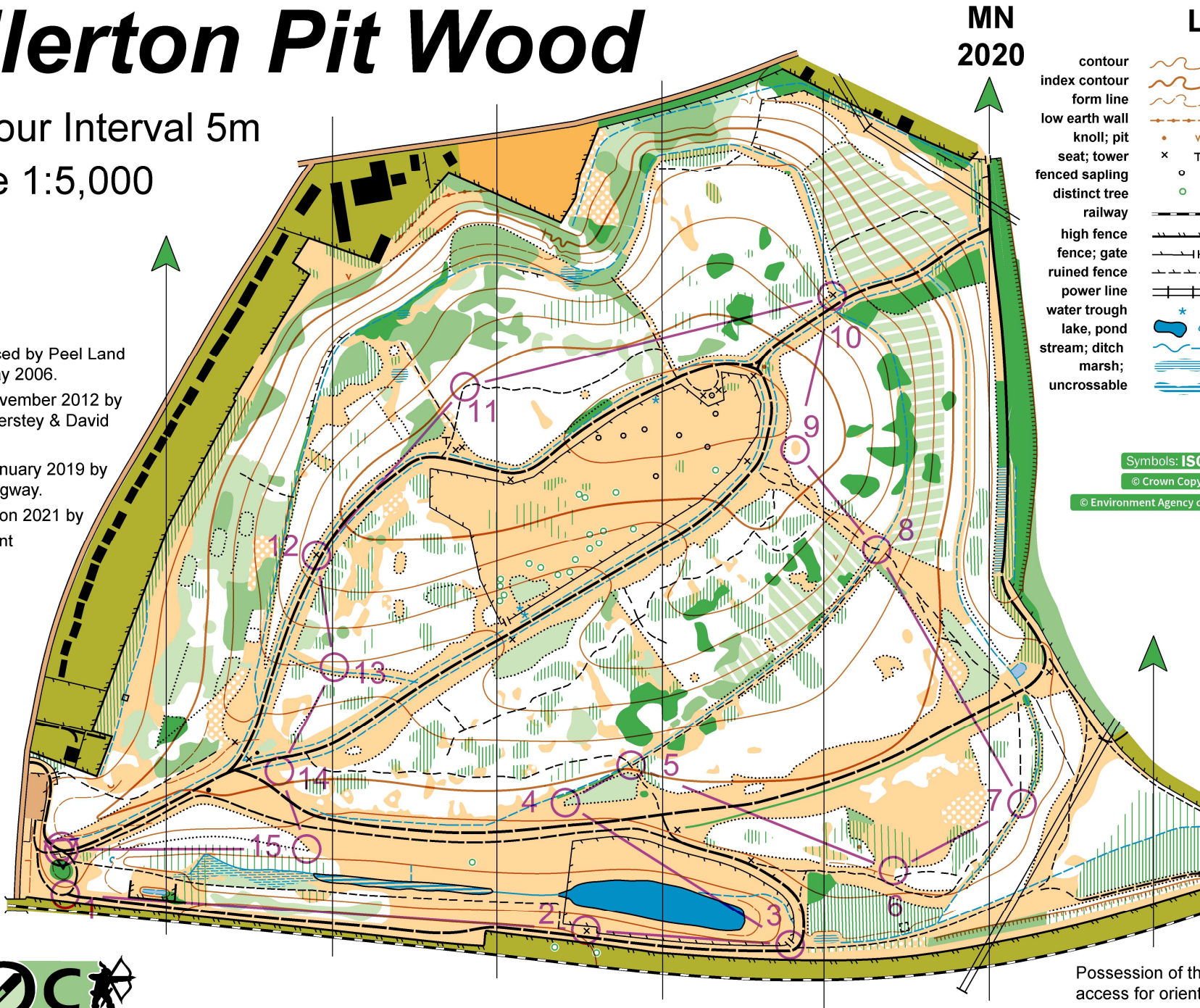


Ollerton Pit Wood
