I had thought MapRun would not be that much fun but with so many courses now available and being able to compare the results against others it is quite fun to try this. Each club has their own MapRun page

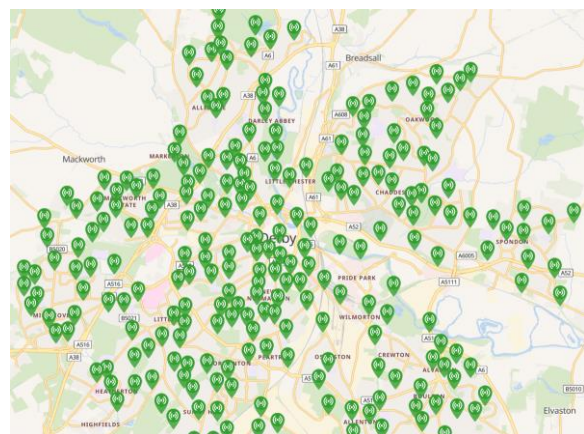

Notes from EMOA Meeting on 19th April 2021

The meeting was held via Zoom due to the coronavirus outbreak.

Financial Secretary's Report - Paul stated "I don't think it will come as a surprise to anyone that financial activity has been very limited over the last few months.

In terms of movements since the last meeting we have continued to see the steady inflow of Membership payments via BOF (anecdotally a few of my friends have only just renewed membership for 2021 now that clubs are able to put on events again) there is likely to be a little more income to come via this route over the next few months. The only expense incurred is the purchase of a new trophy for the M75 category.

In other finance related matters, DVO has recently discussed the Chatsworth mapping prepayment from some years back. They continue to experience challenges in arranging a large event on the site but still hope to be able to run a lower level event in the future and as such the prepayment will be settled.

It is possible we will get more renewals as events take off again (it was noted that the British Middle Distance event entries opened the day of the meeting). At this stage we are $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way through the year and have most membership levies in, but have not spent much so the committee may want to think how we can best use the income.

Development - EMOA Development Conference - Randal still wants to host something for event officials to cover some of the key issues (e.g. the use of risk assessments particularly in relation to COVID). It is likely to be either in June, or more likely in September.

Development Courses and Use of Zoom - Discussions took place on the best length for an on-line zoom session. It was felt that keeping sessions to around an hour was the optimum time. The advantages of zoom type sessions is there is no cost, and for longer conferences you don't have to attend all the sessions. However, the real benefits of conferences and workshops is often in the discussions around the edge of the conference which you don't get when conferences are on-line.

Coaching - The most recent safeguarding workshops had been attended by quite a few coaches in the region (DVO - 7, LEI - 2, LOG - 2, NOC - 5). Not attending the workshops does not

prevent coaches from coaching but it may impact insurance for some coaching as the coach may not be licensed.

For anyone working with others as a coach we want to encourage best practice. There is a good summary of safeguarding on the BOF website at

<https://www.britishorienteering.org.uk/news/5562>. If a coach only works with adults, then they need to take an online safeguarding workshop. British Orienteering's new [Introduction to Safeguarding eLearning course](#) would count for adult only coaches. If a coach works with juniors then they need to undertake the UK coaching course - see <https://www.ukcoaching.org/courses/course-list?bookableonly=false&types=Online&pricefrom=0&priceto=0&distance=25&order=relevant>.

Fixtures -

EMOA League 2021 / EMOA Urban League 2021 - One question asked was whether we should still award points for events with restricted entry numbers. At this stage we will continue to award points and include these events in the league. There may be future events where there are limited entries as we come out of lockdown so would encourage members to enter early. There is still a likelihood that events may not all take place, but we will try to maintain a league based on these restrictions.

1. Future Major Events

- i) **27 Jun 2021 - East Midlands Champs 2021** - DVO - Chinley Churn - Landowner permissions already granted so should be able to enter soon.
- ii) **12 Sep 2021 - East Midlands Sprint Champs** - NOC - Area to be decided
- iii) **17 Oct 2021 - CompassSport Cup Final 2021** - OD - Permission for Chatsworth could not be agreed so moved to OD
- iv) **29 Jan 2022 - Pre-Midland Champs** - DVO - Area to be decided
- v) **30 Jan 2022 - Midland Champs** - NOC - Sherwood Forest
- vi) **20 Mar 2022 - East Midlands Champs 2022** - DVO - Stanton Moor - will be a level B event
- vii) **3 Jul 2022 - Yvette Baker Trophy Final 2022** - LEI - Irchester
- viii) **8 Oct 2022 - British Schools Score Champs** - DVO - Shipley Park

Pauline Olivant noted that next year NOC would not be able to maintain their full quota of events as in previous years due to membership decline, access and getting officials.

Equality of Winning Times for Female athletes - There was some discussion on BOF looking at this. The latest BOF statement in Board meeting minutes was "Equity of competitions distances or run times for women. The Chief Executive informed the meeting that he had been contacted about a request for equality of running time for both men's and women's competitions in Regional and National Championships. The Board confirmed their commitment to equality in all aspects of the sport. Scott Collier informed the meeting that he was aware that in Sweden that they had recently introduced equal winning times for men's and women's courses at their domestic competitions. David Rosen informed the meeting that the winning times for men and women have been equalised in IOF Ski-O and MTBO races, but not yet in IOF Foot-O Long

Distance races. It was agreed that although this may seem like a simple and straightforward request, it had wide-ranging implications and the potential to impact many members and therefore we would need to consult widely on the subject. It was agreed that the Board would draft a Terms of Reference for a working group to conduct the consultation and review and to make recommendations for consideration by the Events & Competitions Committee. It was also agreed that we should openly advertise and recruit for the position of Chair and members of the working group."

Dates and venues for future meetings – The next scheduled committee meeting is June 21st. It is planned to use Zoom for the meeting. Non-committee members are welcome to attend, so please contact the minutes secretary for details if wish to attend.

The following meeting would be the AGM which is scheduled for 13th September. Discussions at the June meeting will decide on whether this should be an in person meeting or whether we should use Zoom.

East Midlands Junior Squad



The squad are just about to shift into third gear.

The experienced group of 6 are continuing and the squad are developing the next group of 5-7. Sessions are held on Zoom. During May/June, 7 training events are planned including Bagworth, South Common, and the 4 DVO local events where it is intended to embellish the short course with training, then have a competitive run. There are selection races for British Teams coming up. Some members are being encouraged to go to

Hambledon where the squad will team up with South Central Squad. The aim is to have a set of quality events before the British Middle Distance champs take place. There should also be a Junior Squad event on the Friday evening.

The intention is to get the experienced orienteers ready, so they have good results and get selected for Lagganlia and Deeside.

Talent Pools for the Scots, Northern and Southern orienteers are used to feed into the British Squad. These talent pools are at a higher level to regional squads.

There are fluid selection policies at present due to COVID.

The EMJOS have also updated the consent form and updated the child safe policy for the squad.

Orienteering Foundation Report

The Chair of the Foundation has been taken over by Andrew Evans (DFOK), Neil Cameron

(NGOC) the retiring chair is saying a trustee. Duncan Archer (CLOK) has also stepped down as a Trustee after 6 years on the Board and he will continue as an Ambassador for the North East. We also welcomed Georgia Jones to her first meeting in January as a Trustee. She is a recent graduate from Exeter University and was the driving force behind the establishment of their new club (OROX).



Latest news

- Forth Valley Orienteers being awarded a grant to support for extending the hours of their Club Development Officer.
- The Trail O Development Steering group were awarded a grant for the production of a promotional video.
- Over £6,000 had been donated by BOC 2020 entrants to the Foundation by declining their entry refund in favour of using it for JROS support.
- Unfortunately, because of Covid, further coaching days will not be held until at least towards the end of 2021.
- The Foundation is sponsoring a "think tank" project where the Foundation will appoint a small group of participants to review orienteering issues and make proposals. This will be done in close cooperation with British Orienteering. The pilot will look at the issue of improving the retention of newcomers to orienteering.

Charnwood Forest Report

My report is not a National Forest report as such as we are not meeting at present and the nature of the meetings make zooming not worth it. Most of the efforts of the top team at the Forest Company are currently directed at the Charnwood Forest Project. Charnwood Forest is of course a part of the National Forest Area. The Steering Group for the project do zoom regularly and I am on the group as a board member of the Charnwood Forest Regional Park

The project is in the name of the Charnwood Forest Landscape Partnership comprising members of the Park Board, officers from the district and borough authorities involved, the County Council, The quarry industry, National Farmers Union and wildlife trust.

We have been successful in a lottery bid and now have a budget of over three million pounds to spend over the next five years in enhancing and protecting the forest area and educational projects aimed at getting local people to appreciate its importance and the need to protect it.

Access is a large part of the project and new paths are going in creating safe off-road links between open areas which will help with orienteering events. A visitor centre is being constructed at the Outwoods which hopefully will assist us when we want to stage events there and to sell POC maps. A shelter is also to be built as an outdoor school facility in Swithland Wood which also might be a base for events.

Major planting schemes have dried up but some smaller woodland sites have been acquired and planted up, but the effort now is on connectivity between these, which might make using some of them a practicality

Bradgate Park Trust are on the steering group but a year after the top man (*a good friend to orienteering*) resigned, the lady running the park day to day has also decided to leave. She was another good contact, who had in the past helped us, first as an officer of the County Council, then as officer in charge of outdoor areas at Oadby & Wigston Council, before taking up her role at Bradgate

I know many of the understaff at the park, and they have met the new top man a few times, but the new regime are not operating in a manner conducive to long term event planning.

Details on entry are normally available on the club sites. Unless otherwise stated, Local events offer entry on the day (EOD) to a range of colour coded courses with start times from 10:30 to 12:30. Some will provide a wider range of courses than others. Regional events provide colour coded within which age classes can be run. National events provide a range of age-related courses and are normally entered in advance.

The OS map reference is either the car park or point from which the event will be signposted. The list is based on BOF registration, but events are sometimes cancelled. If you are uncertain of whether an event will be on, check with the organiser. The editor takes no responsibility for wasted journeys.

Many events are currently pre-entry only, so please check the event details before travelling.
